## The making of our image of Toypurina

## Why is this image inaccurate?

This commonly used image is from a project under famous artist Judy Baca. She found this picture of a mestiza (having Spanish blood) in the Cal State Los Angeles archives. There is no familial association with Toypurina.



## How did we get our image?

Toypurina lived before photography was available. However, we are fortunate that we do have a photograph of one of her daughters from her Spanish husband. She is the second from the right. We took this image, along with a current photograph of Toypurina's 6<sup>th</sup> great granddaughter, and asked artist The Nyugen of Cal State Fullerton to mesh them together to produce a realistic image of what Toypurina could have looked like. It is this image that artist Rick Hill used to make a bronze bust of her. We are hoping to have a life sized statue of her placed in San Gabriel.
